## DELAWARE COUNTY PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT

### MONTHLY POLICE BLOTTER

\*The below captions are a summary of significant police responses during the listed month. The blotter does not include all calls for service attended to by the Delaware County Park Police Department.

May 2026

- **05/01/2026 0830 Medical Emergency**  
Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.
- **05/01/2026 1245 Narcotics Possession**  
Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex discovered a small foil bag containing marijuana on an individual while screening them into the complex. Officers confiscated the marijuana and recorded the information of the individual before releasing them. The marijuana was then submitted as evidence to be destroyed.
- **05/01/2026 1603 County Park Ordinance Enforcement**  
Officers assigned to Parks Patrol conducted county park ordinance enforcement at Rose Tree Park after observing an influx of drivers attempting to speed/cut through the park. Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle cutting through the park and issued a citation for the county park ordinance violation before releasing the driver.
- **05/02/2026 0932 Medical Emergency**  
Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched to a medical emergency at the Sharon Hill Training Center. Officers Upon arrival, officers assisted EMS as needed as well as obtaining all pertinent information. Officers cleared after EMS transported the Pt. to the local Hospital.

- **05/03/2026 1500 County Park Ordinance Enforcement**  
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol conducted county park ordinance enforcement at Rose Tree Park after observing an influx of drivers attempting to speed/cut through the park. Officers stopped multiple vehicles and issued multiple citations.
- **05/03/2026 1624 Unauthorized Vehicles**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division stopped a juvenile riding a dirt bike on the property. The juvenile was detained and the parents were called to collect the bike and juvenile. A warning was issued and the juvenile was released into custody of the parents.
- **05/06/2026 1555 Narcotics Possession**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex discovered a container of unmarked pills on an individual while screening them into the complex. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the individual did not have a prescription for the pills. The pills were confiscated and submitted for destruction and information on the individual was obtained before they were released with a warning.
- **05/06/2026 1430 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to Sharon Hill Probation received information for an individual with a violation of probation warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to Delaware County Prison.
- **05/07/2026 1305 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to Sharon Hill Probation received information for an individual with a violation of probation warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. Upon a transport officer arriving to transport the subject to Delaware County Prison the individual advised officers they were having chest pains. Officers performed basic first aid procedures until Medics arrived to take care of them. The subject was then transported to the local hospital with custody being transferred to Probation Officers.
- **05/07/2026 1631 Burglary alarms**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a burglary alarm in one of the buildings on the property. Responding officers found that it was a false alarm.
- **05/08/2026 0014 Medical Emergency**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.

- **05/08/2026 1652 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex had an individual arrive to the complex advising that they wanted to turn themselves in for an active warrant. Officers verified that the subject had an active warrant and once verified took the individual into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to Delaware County Prison.
- **05/08/2026 1650 Theft \$200 dollars or more**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex had an individual walk in advising that they needed to speak with deputy from the Sheriff's Office. Upon further investigation the individual advised that they received a phone call stating that they were going to be arrested if they did not take out large amounts of money and send it via barcodes. Suspecting the individual might be the victim of fraud, officers initiated an official investigation finding that the Sheriff's Office never contacted the individual and that it was most likely a scam. All pertinent information was collected and then passed on to the Investigations Division.
- **05/09/2026 1020 Assist other Agencies**  
 Officers assigned to Park Patrol conducted a traffic detail assisting other Police agencies with a large memorial service. Officers assisted with stopping and directing traffic for the detail.
- **05/09/2026 1514 Fraud**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse complex received a report that another individual had received a call from the Sheriffs Dept. The caller told the individual they owed \$2000 dollars and would be arrested if not paid. Suspecting the individual might be the victim of fraud, officers initiated an official investigation finding that the Sheriff's Office never contacted the individual and that it was most likely a scam. All pertinent information was collected and then passed on to the Investigations Division.
- **05/10/2026 1649 Medical Emergency**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.
- **05/11/2026 1110 Panic Alarms**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex received a report of a Panic Alarm in one of the offices. Arriving officers located two individuals arguing in the office. After de-escalating the situation officers spoke with the employees of the office and it was decided the individuals would be allowed to finish conducting their business as long as they remained calm and respectful.

- **05/12/2026 0915 Warrants**  
Officers assigned to Sharon Hill Probation received information for an individual with a violation of probation warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to Delaware County Prison.
- **05/12/2026 1503 Medical Emergency**  
Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.
- **05/13/2026 0908 Warrants**  
Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were alerted to an individual with an active warrant out of Chester City. Officers made contact with the individual and confirmed their identity. After confirming their identity, the warrant was also confirmed, and the subject was taken into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to Chester City Police Department.
- **05/13/2026 0930 Medical Emergency**  
Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex received a report of a possible sick person in one of the courtrooms. Responding officers spoke with the individual and determined EMS was required. Medics were dispatched and officers assisted as needed until medics transported the patient to the local hospital.
- **05/13/2026 1130 Fraud**  
Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex took a walk-up complaint from an individual who wanted to report a possible scam/fraud. Officers took the individual's information and forwarded everything to the Investigations Division for detectives to make contact with the individual. Detectives contacted the individual and determined the potential fraud had taken place in another jurisdiction. Detectives assisted the individual by referring them to their local Police Dept. where the incident took place.
- **05/14/2026 1117 Panic Alarms**  
Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a panic alarm in one of the offices. Responding officers discovered an ongoing conference that was becoming loud. Officers de-escalated the situation and remained on location until the conference ended without further issue.
- **05/15/2026 Harassment by Communication**  
Officers received a report of a county employee being harassed/ threats being made. Officers and Detectives initiated an official investigation into the matter.

- **05/15/2026 1126 Mental Health**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a report of an individual thought to be having a mental crisis. Arriving officers determined mobile crisis services would be needed and called them to assist with the individual on scene. After some time, the individual refused any further assistance. After it was determined the individual was not a danger to themselves or others, they were given information to resources available prior to them leaving the property.
- **05/16/2026 1234 Fire Alarms**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a fire alarm in one of the buildings. Officers and the Fire Department responded and determined it to be a false alarm.
- **05/17/2026 1641 Medical Emergency**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.
- **05/18/2026 1027 Disorderly conduct**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex received a report of a fight outside of one of the courtrooms. Responding officers found that one party already had already left and the other half who remained on location was able to give the identity of the other party. After a review of footage in the area of the fight it was determined to be mutual combat. The individual who remained on scene was issued a citation and the other party would be receiving a citation as by mail.
- **05/18/2026 1403 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to Chester Probation received report of an individual with an active Warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident and later the subject was transferred to Delaware County Prison.
- **05/19/2026 1639 County Park Ordinance Violations**  
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol conducted county park ordinance enforcement at Rose Tree Park after observing an influx of drivers attempting to speed/cut through the park. Officers stopped multiple vehicles and issued multiple citations.
- **05/20/2026 1330 Medical Emergency**

 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex witnessed a verbal argument between two parties involved in a custody dispute. All parties were separated and officers along with the assistance of lawyers for both parties were able to De-escalate the situation. Following this, the parties were able to come to an agreement without further issue.
- **05/22/2026 1115 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to the Upper Darby Probation Office received notification of an individual who had violated their probation and now has an active warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to the Delaware County Prison.
- **05/23/2026 1250 Medical Emergency**  
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.
- **05/24/2026 1704 Assist other Agencies**  
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex responded to a call for assistance by Media Police Department Officers who were dealing with multiple subjects on State St. Officers assisted as needed and then cleared.
- **05/26/2026 0930 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to Chester District Court were made aware of an individual with an active warrant out of Chester. Officers took the subject into custody without incident and then later transferred to Chester Police Headquarters.
- **05/27/2026 1030 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to Sharon Hill Probation received information for an individual with a violation of probation warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to Delaware County Prison.
- **05/27/2026 1430 Warrants**  
 Officers assigned to the Upper Darby Probation Office received notification of an individual who had violated their probation and now has an active warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to the Delaware County Prison.
- **05/28/2026 1133 Drug Possession**  
 Officers assigned to the Upper Darby Probation Office discovered marijuana on an individual while screening them into the facility. The individual advised that they did not have a valid medical card. Officers contacted the individual's probation officer with their findings. The individual's probation officer made note and confiscated the marijuana for destruction.

Officers assigned to assist with the Cardinal O'Hara Hero Bowl dealt with a multitude of individuals who were fighting during the event around half time. Due to the size of the unruly crowd, the remainder of the event was cancelled and all officers remained on location assisting until all the subjects had been dispersed.
- **05/29/2026 1012 Medical emergency**  
Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers responded and assisted EMS as needed until the patient was transported to the local hospital for further treatment.
- **05/29/2026 1000 Warrants**
